Nearly two months ago, I made a federal FOIA request of the United States Coast Guard (see attached) requesting certain transcripts and tapes of radio communications. To date, although the FOIA requires a federal agency to respond within twenty days, I have not heard from you concerning my request.

Once again, pursuant to *5 U.S.C.A. § 552, et seq.* of the federal Freedom of Information Act, I hereby request transcripts and tapes of all radio communications from Catalina Island to the United States Coast Guard Station Los Angeles/ Long Beach between 0100 hours and 0900 hours on November 29, 1981.

Please extend us the courtesy of responding to this FOIA request – either up or down. If down, please state your reasons in accordance with federal law. If I do not hear from you within 15 days of the date of this request, you will leave me with no alternative other than to file suit to obtain the records I am seeking.
