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WE SEARCHED THE BOAT AND FOUND THAT THE ZODIAC DINGHY WAS MISSING. WE THEN THOUGHT THAT NATALIE HAD GONE ASHORE TO THE BAR, THIS ALL TOOK PLACE AROUND 12:00 MIDNIGHT. WHEN SHE DIDN'T RETURN BY 1:30 AM I GOT ON THE RADIO & CALLED THE ISTHMUS TO SEE IF SHE WAS THERE. I GOT A HOLD OF SOME GUYS WHO WORKED AT THE ISTHMUS AND ASKED IF THEY COULD CHECK THE ISTHMUS FOR NATALIE. WHEN THE GUYS AT THE ISTHMUS CHECKED AND COULDN'T FIND THE BOAT AT THE DOCK THEY STARTED SEARCHING THE BAY, AND CONTACTED THE COASTGUARD."

AT THIS TIME I CONTACTED L.A. CO. LIFEGUARDS, WHO WERE SEARCHING THE COASTLINE IN THEIR BOAT, AND WAS ADVISED THAT THE "ZODIAC" DINGHY HAD BEEN FOUND IN THE ROCKS AT "BLUE CAVERN POINT", APPROX 1/4 MI. NORTH EAST OF ISTHMUS PIER. A SEARCH OF THE WATER & COAST LINE HAD BEEN MADE WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS.

AT APPROX. 0615 HRS. I UPDATED SGT. DYER, AVALON STATION, RE: THE ABOVE INFORMATION AND REQUESTED A FIRST LIGHT HELICOPTER SEARCH BY SHERIFF'S AERO BUREAU. I ALSO REQUESTED THE AVALON SHERIFF'S SEARCH & RESCUE TEAM FOR A GROUND SEARCH OF "BLUE CAVERN POINT".

AT 0630 HRS I ACCOMPANIED W/ R. WAGNER TO THE VESSEL "SPLENDOUR" IN ORDER TO CONDUCT A COMPLETE SEARCH OF THE VESSEL FOR VICT. WAGNER. THE SEARCH WAS MADE WITH W/WAGNER'S COMPLETE CO-OPERATION. THE SEARCH WAS MADE WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS. WHILE CONDUCTING THE SEARCH I OBS'D PIECES

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OF A BROKEN WINE BOTTLE LAYING ON THE DECK CARPETING OF THE MAIN SALON. I ALSO OBS'D PARTIALLY EATEN FOOD, EMPTY WINE BOTTLES, AND CLOTHING SCATTERED ABOUT THE CABIN.

AT APPROX. 0645 I BOARDED L.A. CO. LIFEGUARD BOAT "ISTHMUS BAYWATCH" & MET WITH LT'S SMITH & STONIRE (WIT'S 9910). WE MADE A SEARCH PATROL TO "BLUE CAVERN POINT" WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS. AN UNDERWATER SEARCH WAS THEN MADE UNDER AND AROUND THE VESSEL "SPLENDOR", AGAIN WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS.

AT 0740 SHERIFF'S HELICOPTER AIR-53 ARRIVED AT THE ISTHMUS AND STARTED A SEARCH OF THE "BLUE CAVERN POINT" AREA. AT APPROX. 0745 HRS. AIR-53 OBS'D VICT. WAGNER'S BODY FLOATING APPROX 250 YDS NORTH OF BLUE CAVERN POINT. THE VICT'S BODY WAS RETRIEVED FROM THE WATER BY MYSELF & L.A. CO. LIFEGUARDS LT'S SMITH & STONIRE WITH THE HELP OF ISTHMUS HARBOR PATROL BOAT UNIT-I. THE VICT'S BODY WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE U.S.C. MARINE LAB, LOCATED AT THE ISTHMUS, TO AWAIT THE ARRIVAL OF SHERIFF'S HOMICIDE DETECTIVES AND THE CORONER'S OFFICE. WHILE ENROUTE TO U.S.C. MARINE LAB, A VISUAL EXAMINATION WAS MADE OF THE VICT. A SMALL LACERATION WAS OBS'D ON THE BRIDGE OF THE VICT'S NOSE, AND SMALL BRUISES WERE OBS'D ON VICT'S ARMS & LEGS.

AT THE TIME THE VICT'S BODY WAS RECOVERED SHE WAS WEARING A ONE PIECE DRESS, BLU. SOCKS, AND A RED DOWN JACKET. JEWELRY INCLUDED (Y/M RING (SCARAB BEETLE DESIGN)) & Y/M CHAIN BRACELET ON R/HAND. L/HAND, Y/M RING (SQUARE KNOT DESIGN) Y/M RING (NUMEROUS ENTWINED CIRCLES) (Y/M RING

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WITH W/STONES, 4/M JEWELRY CHAIN AROUND VICT'S WAIST.

AT 0830 HRS. WIT, DAVERN, CAPT. OF THE "SPLENDOUR" ARRIVED, AND POSITIVELY IDENTIFIED THE BODY AS THAT OF VICT, NATALIE WAGNER (WOOD).

→ WHILE AT THE MARINE LAB WIT, DAVERN MADE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT AS TO THE EVENTS LEADING UP TO VICT. WAGNER'S BEING DISCOVERED MISSING. "WE (VICT. & WIT.

1, 2, & 3) HAD GONE ASHORE IN THE AFTERNOON TO HAVE DINNER. WE SAT IN THE BAR DRINKING UNTIL 7:00 PM OR 8:00 PM AND THEN HAD DINNER. WE LEFT FOR THE BOAT AROUND 10:00 PM OR 11:00 PM AND CONTINUED DRINKING ON BOARD. AT ABOUT 12:00 MIDNIGHT WE DISCOVERED NATALIE WAS MISSING AND THE "ZODIAC" WAS MISSING. WE THOUGHT THAT SHE HAD JUST GONE ASHORE AND BACK TO THE BAR. WE COULDN'T GO AND CHECK BECAUSE WE HAD NO WAY OF GETTING ASHORE. AT ABOUT 1:30 AM WHEN NATALIE STILL HADN'T RETURNED "J.R.", (WIT, WAGNER), CONTACTED SOME ISTHMUS EMPLOYEES (WIT'S 4 & 5) AND ASKED THEM TO LOOK FOR NATALIE ON SHORE. WHEN THEY COULDN'T FIND HER ASHORE A SEARCH OF THE HARBOR WAS STARTED."

I ADVISED WIT, DAVERN TO RETURN TO THE "SPLENDOUR" AND REMAIN THERE UNTIL CONTACTED BY SHERIFF'S HOMICIDE DETECTIVES.

AT 0900 HRS. SHERIFF'S RESERVE MICHAEL HARVIN TOOK CHARGE OF VICT'S BODY AT THE MARINE LAB. AT 0915 I RESPONDED TO THE SHERIFF'S ISTHMUS FACILITY & MET WITH AVALON STATION COMMANDER LT. COLLINS. LT COLLINS

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ADVISED ME THAT WIT'S. R. WAGNER AND C. WALKEN HAD BEEN TRANSPORTED TO THE SHERIFF'S AERIAL BUREAU, AT THEIR REQUEST, AND THEY WOULD BE INTERVIEWED BY SHERIFFS HOMICIDE DETECTIVES THERE. LT. COLLINS ALSO DIRECTED THAT I CONTACT ALL AVAILABLE WITNESSES & HAVE THEM AVAILABLE TO BE INTERVIEWED BY HOMICIDE UPON THEIR ARRIVAL.

WIT. #11 BAUER, BARTENDER AT ISTHMUS BAR, WAS CONTACTED AT 0730 HRS. & ADVISED THAT HIS STATEMENT WOULD BE NEEDED BY SHERIFF'S HOMICIDE DETECTIVES WHEN THEY ARRIVED. WIT. BAUER IMMEDIATELY CONTACTED LT. COLLINS AT THE SHERIFF'S ISTHMUS FACILITY & REQUESTED HIS STATEMENT BE TAKEN IMMEDIATELY AS HE HAD TO LEAVE THE ISLAND ON THE MORNING BOAT. LT. COLLINS TOOK WIT. BAUER'S STATEMENT WHICH IS AS FOLLOWS " AT ABOUT 3:30 PM BOB & NATALIE WAGNER ALONG WITH 2 OTHER MEN (MOUNT PROPER) CAME INTO THE BAR & STARTED DRINKING, NATALIE DRANK RUM, THEY CONTINUED TO DRINK UNTIL 7:30 PM OR 8:00 PM, THEY WERE QUIET & DIDN'T CAUSE ANY PROBLEMS. NEITHER NATALIE OR BOB WAGNER ACTED DRUNK, BUT BOTH THE OTHER MALES APPEARED INTOXICATED BY THE TIME THEY WENT IN TO DINNER AT ABOUT 7:45 PM, AT ABOUT 10:00 PM I SAW THEM AGAIN AND ALL FOUR PARTIES APPEARED INTOXICATED. AT 10:15 PM ALL 4 MADE A TOAST & BROKE THEIR WINE GLASSES. ALL 4 LEFT RIGHT AFTER THE TOAST & NATALIE WAS PRETTY "SHAKY". DON WHITING, RESTAURANT MGR,

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called Kurt Craig at the Harbor Patrol Office to tell him they were on their way down and to make sure they got back to their boat." WIT. BAUER went on to state VICT. WAGNER had been dressed in designer jeans (BLUR), a yellow sweater, and a red down jacket. In addition he stated she had on a necklace & 2 or more rings.

WITNESS SMITH, LA. CO. LIFEGUARD BAYWATCH ISTHMUS, stated he was first contacted regarding the missing person at 0515 HRS BY THE U.S. COAST GUARD. THE COAST GUARD ADVISED HIM OF THE MISSING PERSON & BOAT AND REQUESTED THEIR ASSISTANCE IN THE SEARCH. THE COAST GUARD WENT ON TO STATE THAT THE SEARCH HAD BEEN GOING ON SINCE APPROX. 0130 HRS AND THAT THE COAST GUARD CUTTER "POINT CAMDEN" WAS DISPATCHED TO THE SCENE AND SHOULD BE IN LOCATION AT 0530 HRS. BAYWATCH IMMEDIATELY RESPONDED TO THEIR PATROL VESSEL TO ASSIST IN THE SEARCH, AND UPON LEARNING THAT THE SHERIFF'S DEPT. HAD ALSO NOT BEEN NOTIFIED REQUESTED U.S. COAST GUARD CONTACT AVALON SHERIFF'S STATION. AT ABOUT 0530 WE WERE CONTACTED BY THE ISTHMUS HARBOR PATROL & ADVISED THE MISSING ZODIAC DINGHY HAD BEEN FOUND AGAINST THE ROCKS AT BLUE CAVERN POINT. HOWEVER VICT. WAGNER WAS STILL MISSING. BOTH A COASTAL SEARCH OF ISTHMUS HARBOR & BLUE CAVERN POINT, PLUS AN UNDERWATER SEARCH OF THE OCEAN BOTTOM AROUND THE "SPLENDOR" WAS MADE WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS. WHEN THE BODY WAS OBS'D BY THE SHERIFF'S HELICOPTER, WE ASSISTED IN RECOVERING AND TRANSPORTING MRS. WAGNER'S BODY

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TO THRU S.C. MARINE LAB FOR TRANSPORT TO THE MAINLAND
